IMPERIAL ROSE - 4TH - TE RAPA MAIDEN 1100M

Imperial Rose ran well in trying conditions at Te Rapa on Friday. She loomed to win the race, but just got beaten by a few better on the day. Trainer Stephen Marsh feels that she will benefit from a good spell and will come back as a 3yo in the Spring.

BEAR ON THE LOOSE & JUST FINE - RANDWICK GROUP 3 2000M

Bear On The Loose and Just Fine went head-to-head in the Group 3 JRA Plate on Saturday at Randwick. Both horses put in an honest performance, with Bear On The Loose only being beaten by 1 length, and Just Fine not disgracing himself after missing the start. We will await to hear from the stable as to their next steps.

HIGH TEMPO - 2ND - SALE BM62 1746M

High Tempo was brave in defeat at Sale on Sunday, being narrowly defeated in the dying stages of the race. She has been super in this preparation and has been consistent across all of her runs. She may head towards the Warrnambool racing carnival, where she will relish the wet tracks there!

CHICAGO KING - 4TH - IPSWICH 0-60 1350M

Chicago King was unfortunately beaten by the barrier on Thursday at Ipswich. Jockey Boris Thornton made an aggressive move to put him up on speed, and he gave a really good sight until he was grabbed late by horses that had a kinder run in transit.

MAWJOOD - 7TH - WARWICK FARM BM72 1200M

Mawjood put in a good first-up performance on Wednesday at Warwick Farm. Olivia Chambers rode to instructions and rode Mawjood cold, but was probably a bit too far back to trouble the placegetters in the end. He now potentially heads to a BM88 at Hawkesbury over 1400m on May 2nd.
